

## CALL-IN APPLICATIONS: REHABILITATION PROGRAM (ROOFING ONLY)



The City of Alexandria's Community Development Department will accept applications for the Minor Housing Rehabilitation Program from Monday, November 22, 2021 through Wednesday, November 24, 2021, starting at 9:00 am and ending at 3:00 pm each day. Applications will not be taken from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm for lunch. Funding is provided through the CDBG-CV 1 & 3 federal grants.

To apply for the Minor Housing Rehabilitation Program, homeowners may call 318.449.5074/5072 or may apply online at [www.mygovernmentonline.org](http://www.mygovernmentonline.org) beginning Monday, November 22, 2021. Applicants will be given further instructions on how to complete their application during the call. Qualified applicants may be eligible to receive assistance for roofing repairs as deemed feasible by the Community Development Department.

Residents, that meet the criteria below, including being under the gross annual income limits, are eligible to apply:

- CALL IN to apply during the application period OR apply online at [www.mygovernmentonline.org](http://www.mygovernmentonline.org) starting on November 22, 2021.
- Currently OWN AND OCCUPY the home where assistance is being requested.
  - any person applying on behalf of a home owner must present legal power of attorney documentation at the time of application.
- Meet the current HUD income limits for the number of people living in the house.
  - Provide proof of income for ALL persons over age 18 living in the household.
  - Acceptable proof of income includes: Earnings Statement, Benefit Award Letter, W2 or signed Income Verification from employer(s)
- Provide valid picture ID of each home owner(s) listed on the property deed and/or mortgage.
- Live in the Alexandria City limits
- Prior year awards in the last 5 years may affect eligibility
