Duties also to include, but not limited to installs, maintains, and repairs underground and overhead structures, climbs poles, rides in truck-mounted boom bucket to install equipment and installs transformers, insulators, lightning arresters, switches, wire conductors and auxiliary equipment to poles.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School diploma or GED; vocational or technical coursework in electrical transmission and distribution is preferred; supplemented by progressively responsible work in the electric distribution field; or any equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
