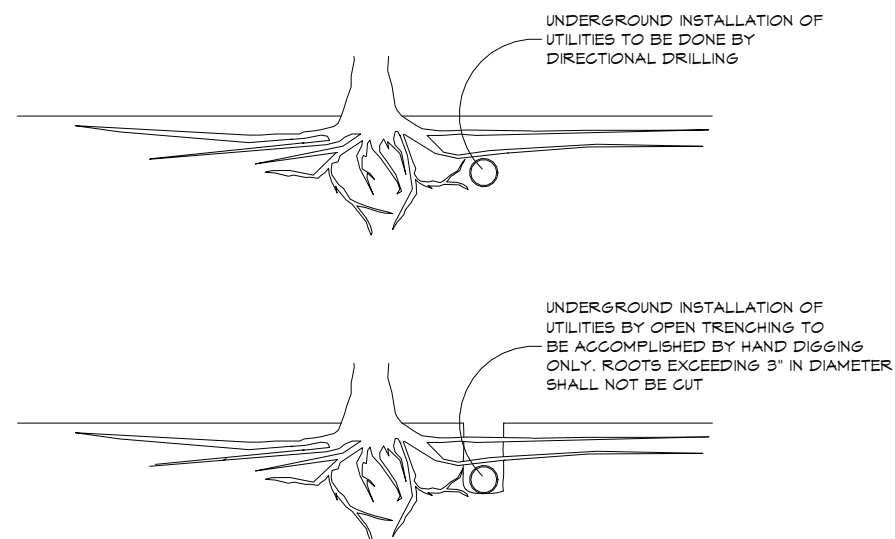


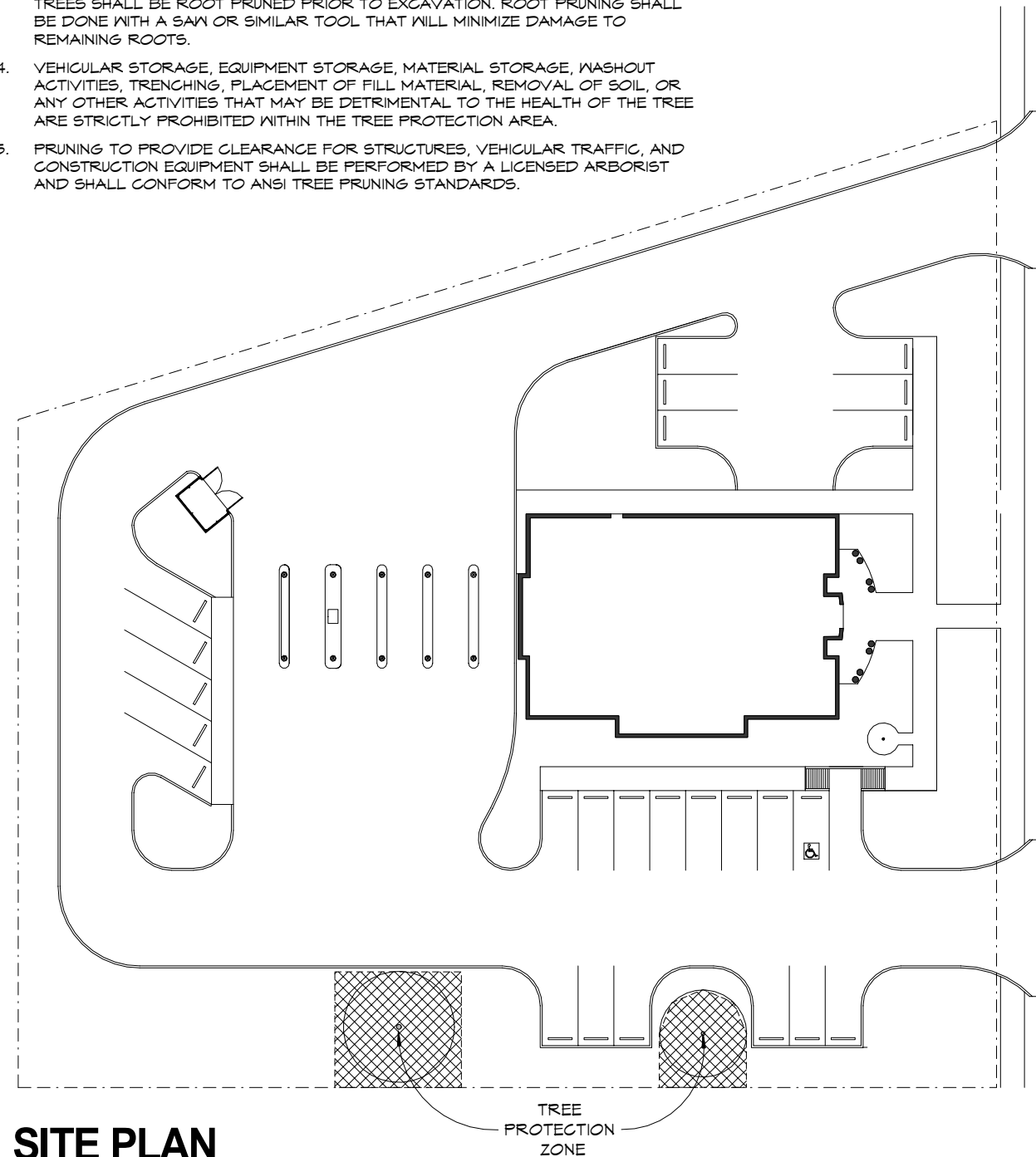
## TREE PROTECTION ZONE DETAIL



## TRENCHING DETAILS

### TREE PROTECTION PLAN NOTES:

1. TREE PROTECTION FENCE SHALL BE INSTALLED AROUND THE TREE PROTECTION AREA PRIOR TO ANY SITE PREPARATION OR CONSTRUCTION WORK AND MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE PROJECT.
2. SILT FENCING OR SOIL DIKES SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO ANY SITE PREPARATION OR CONSTRUCTION WORK AND MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE PROJECT TO PREVENT THE BUILDUP OF SEDIMENT WITHIN THE TREE PROTECTION AREA.
3. IN AREAS WHERE CUTS ARE TO BE MADE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF UTILITIES OR RETAINING WALLS ADJACENT TO THE TREE PROTECTION AREA, THE AFFECTED TREES SHALL BE ROOT PRUNED PRIOR TO EXCAVATION. ROOT PRUNING SHALL BE DONE WITH A SAW OR SIMILAR TOOL THAT WILL MINIMIZE DAMAGE TO REMAINING ROOTS.
4. VEHICULAR STORAGE, EQUIPMENT STORAGE, MATERIAL STORAGE, WASHOUT ACTIVITIES, TRENCHING, PLACEMENT OF FILL MATERIAL, REMOVAL OF SOIL, OR ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES THAT MAY BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE HEALTH OF THE TREE ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED WITHIN THE TREE PROTECTION AREA.
5. PRUNING TO PROVIDE CLEARANCE FOR STRUCTURES, VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, AND CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PERFORMED BY A LICENSED ARBORIST AND SHALL CONFORM TO ANSI TREE PRUNING STANDARDS.
