AN ORDINANCE TO REAFFIRM AND CONTINUE AUTHORITY OF THE GREATER ALEXANDRIA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY ("GAEDA") DISTRICT, A SPECIAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE IN RAPIDES PARISH, LOUISIANA AUTHORIZED BY R.S.33:2740.60 (THE "ACT") AND CITY OF ALEXANDRIA ORDINANCE 286-2003 FOR THE PURPOSE OF COOPERATIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITH THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA; AND, OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria, Louisiana, (the "City") has determined that there is a continuing need within the City and the Parish of Rapides, Louisiana (the "Parish") for funding for economic development efforts and renovation, restoration and development within the City to foster tourism and economic development as provided for by the Act; and,

WHEREAS, under authority from the Act, the City Council, by Ordinance 286-2003, created a special taxing district ("GAEDA") and political subdivision of the state to provide for and promote the economic development of the city of Alexandria in order to provide for the renovation, restoration, and development of property in the city.

WHEREAS, the Greater Alexandria Economic and Development Authority ("GAEDA") district has an important economic development function, provides opportunity and funding for the benefit of the City and the citizens and GAEDA should continue to be authorized and function for intended purposes, including as a viable economic development partner with the City; and

WHEREAS, GAEDA, the special taxing district, is created for the purpose of cooperative economic development between the city of Alexandria and the special taxing district which should continue; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and the previous ordinance the City desires to continue in force and existence the district and special political subdivision of the State to foster economic development and cooperation with the City and the citizens for benefits to be received.

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria that the Greater Alexandria Economic Development Authority ("GAEDA") district created by Ordinance 286-2003 and as authorized by R.S. 33:2740.60 shall continue to operate and function as a district under powers, limitations and authority previously ordained and shall remain a political subdivision and district to cooperate with the City for economic development and other public functions; and, provided as set forth below in no event shall the district have an existence of less than three years from the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section II. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council that all previous powers and authorities granted to GAEDA and all limitations on the power and authority of GAEDA shall continue; provided, GAEDA, a special taxing district under authority of R.S. 33:2740.60 and Ordinances of the City of Alexandria, may not be dissolved without authority by an ordinance of the City and a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of the entire membership of the GAEDA district board after a 180 day published notice of intention.
