The Council of the City of Alexandria, Louisiana, met in a regularly scheduled meeting session at its regular meeting place, on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at 5:00 P.M. Stated that he was a good steward of the city's money since the city is currently \$400,000 under budget compared to last year.

Public Safety, Works and Transportation Committee Chair, Mr. Porter said that in the previous committee Community Development gave a very informative presentation explaining the process of condemnation. Economic Workforce and Planning Development Committee Chair, Mr. Fuller thanked Ms. Broussard for explaining the Main Street Program and the city's plans for the Weiss and Goldring Building.
