B. Summoned or subpoenaed to appear as a witness before a court, grand jury, or other public body or commission, or to give a deposition, provided it is work-related, and the employee is not a plaintiff. If an employee is subpoenaed to appear or is a party in a personal matter, the employee may elect to use accrued annual leave or be allowed approved leave without pay; (Amended October 1, 2010)

PROPOSED RULE XI§ 4.1

B. Summoned or subpoenaed to appear as a witness before a court, grand jury, or other public body or commission, or to give a deposition. For purposes of this subsection, a plaintiff shall not be considered a witness, nor shall a defendant be considered a witness in a matter that is not related to City of Alexandria work. If an employee is subpoenaed to appear or is a party in a personal matter, the employee may elect to use accrued annual leave or be allowed approved leave without pay; (Amended October 1, 2010)
